Chan Kai-Bong was born in Hong Kong in 1981. Since childhood he studied painting from his father Chan Siu-Min. In his twenties he studied the humanities in Simon Fraser University, Canada, and subsequently graduated with a BA in Fine Art from RMIT University (co-presented with Hong Kong Art School), Hong Kong, in 2012.

Chan Kai-Bong is a painter and an art teacher, favoring oil color and oil pastel. Chan loves to paint ordinary objects and landscapes. These paintings are characterized by the poetic feelings of childhood innocence, perhaps influenced by his daily working with children of various artistic talents. His still life and landscape paintings are sprinkled with prismatic colors, colors that can be evoked only through patient and prolonged observation, as well as childlike imagination.

Since 2012, he joined the group of Fotan Artists and co-exhibited in the Fotan Open Studio annually.
