

Silke is a young, talented artist. She was born 1982 in the Bavarian city Guenzburg and grew up in a, what seemed to be, typical family idyll.

But Silke always felt like someone who was different, who didn't really fit in anywhere.

"Already since childhood, I am occupied with the feelings and actions of people. Since early children's scribbles, paintings with water-colours and drawings, later in crafts and then finally with acrylic paint and canvas, I process the desires, fears, passions and conflicts of humans, animals and nature", Silke says.

Over hundreds of pictures and works accumulated so over time, unseen by the public. Nobody noticed the extent in which her effort and passion were used to create these paintings.

Only when it was impossible to be overlooked any longer and strengthened by the encouragement of a few familiars, she exhibited in 2013 for the first time in public.

Almost all of her works sold with overwhelming resonance. Of course, that encouraged the artist to continue.

Silke's works were already on display in Munich, Hamburg, Leipzig, Salzburg, Bath and Miami and will be presented later this year on the renowned Artexpo in New York City.
