Marius Zabinski was born in Warsaw and showed very early on an interest for drawing and sculpture. At the age of 25 he graduated from the Academy of Fine Arts in Warsaw.

He quickly became a successful painter in his home country. At the invitation of a French art dealer he moved to Paris where solo exhibitions were organized for him in 1981-1983. Galleries abroad –in Norway, Belgium, Luxembourg and Japan- also exhibited his work. In 2006 the InterArt Gallery in New York organized a retrospective of his work and Marius is now represented in several US galleries.

For a number of years Marius experimented with different styles. However he developed a predilection for cubism that offered possibilities not yet explored.

Marius has developed a distinctive form of cubism that is immediately recognizable. The deconstruction of his motive is limited while the drawing is very detailed and of high quality. Also the texture of his paintings and his use of colours and light differs from the cubism of the old masters.

The viewer is quickly captivated by the strong yet delicate impressions expressed through his paintings, providing an intense pleasure to the heart and the mind.
